### **30<sup>th</sup> General Assembly of FIEC Delegates (Bordeaux, August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014)**

#### *Invitation to send a Delegate*

The 30<sup>th</sup> General Assembly of FIEC Delegates will be held in Bordeaux in the afternoon of Wednesday, August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014 (during the FIEC Congress <http://fiec2014.sciencesconf.org>). Each affiliated association is invited to send one or two delegates to the meeting, and should provide for the cost of transportation of its delegates to and from Bordeaux, as well as for accommodation.

#### *Election to the FIEC Board*

There will be an election for new members of the FIEC Board in 2014, on the occasion of the FIEC General Assembly of Delegates. Seven seats will have to be filled by new members of the Board.

The current FIEC Board will make sure that we have at least one potential candidate for each seat. We nonetheless want to make this an open process and will welcome proposals made by Associations affiliated to FIEC.

Candidates for election should fulfill the following conditions :

- be persons of high academic standing, whose reputation can foster the image of FIEC ;
- be willing and able to take an active part in the running of FIEC ;
- be able to communicate either in French or in English, so as to enable debate among Board members.

It is also desirable – but not mandatory – that we maintain a certain balance between various geographic areas where Classical studies are represented, fields of specialization, and genders ; and each country can have only one member on the Board (see FIEC Constitution).

Associations that wish to submit a name for the election of a FIEC Board member should send their proposals, including **full name, academic position, postal address, e-mail address and a short curriculum vitae** (1 page, pdf file), to the FIEC Secretary General **no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014**. Proposals that reach us after this date will be declared invalid.
